- the quality of research using criteria set out in the College Research Plan
- external funding opportunities through the development of outreach programs
- College Research Plans which feature:
  - a) consistency with broader University objectives and values
  - b) indicators and targets relating to research performance
  - c) timetables for monitoring and evaluation
  - d) disposition of resources to support the best activities in selected priority areas
- research administration and research development in the College

The College Research Committee will engage with the University Research Committee through the College Research Committee Chair, or College Dean, to:

- 1) remain informed of university wide policies and issues
- 2) discuss and comment on university wide issues raised at the University Research Committee
